WHERE: The conference will be held at the Marriott Hotel, 9100 Corporate Hills Drive, Wichita, Kansas. FEE: The registration fee is \$150.00 per person for members and \$195 per person for non-members before January 19th, after January 19 the fee becomes \$175 for members and \$220 for non-members. This fee includes evening hors d'oeuvres and two drink tickets on Wednesday, continental breakfast and lunch on Thursday, and breakfast buffet on Friday, refreshment breaks, and conference materials. Extra meal tickets for guests will be available at the registration desk. To receive the KLTA member discount your 2010 dues must be paid.
